DAY BY DAY DESCRIPTION:

Day 1 (September 05, 2009)

One of our representatives will meet and greet you at the Juan Santamaria International Airport in San Jose. He will help you with your luggage, give you updated information about Costa Rica and your upcoming adventure.

Tonight you will be staying at the Hampton Inn & Suites. This hotel is located at what is called the Airport Boulevard where the famous Fiesta Casino is located. This same day you can start the party, or you can just stay at the hotel and rest for the upcoming adventure.

Day 2 (September 06th 2009)

We hope you didn't party too much last night because this morning our van will pick you up very early to take you to the Pacuare River for your 2 days white water rafting experience. Breakfast is on the way.

Once you arrive to our operation center in Siquirres, our experienced group of guides will explain to you every single detail of the upcoming adventure for you to enjoy the ride in a safe way. Today you will raft down the Pacuare River for about 3 hours, have lunch at the river bank and arrive to our Lodge in the middle of the jungle during the afternoon.

Dinner will be prepared and served by our tour guides and you will have time to chat with all the participants during the whole night if you want to.



Day 3 (September 07th 2009)

Today's morning starts with a hike in the forest and a Canopy Experience. Then after a hearty breakfast at the lodge you will hop on the rafts again for a 2 hours adventure until we get to the pick up point. This is where your van will be waiting to take you to the town of La Fortuna, where the Majestic Arenal Volcano is located. The Arenal Volcano is famous worldwide for two things: The fact that it makes eruptions several times per day and also its fantastic Hot Springs.

This evening you will enjoy a well-deserved time at The Springs - Hot Springs and if you are lucky, you will be able to see the lava coming down from the very top of the volcano.

Day 4 (September 08th 2009)

Enjoy one of the best breakfasts ever at the Restaurant of Tilajari Hotel Resort and take the van for a 30-minute drive for the Sky Adventure. This activity is a must among all the visitors. It includes a ride in the gondolas of the Sky Tram and a ride in the Zip Lines of the Sky Trek. For those of you who don't know what this is, try to google the phrase Canopy Tour and see it yourself.

Lunch will be served at a local restaurant in town and in the afternoon we will head back to the hotel for you to get ready for this night event with music, dinner and dances!



Day 5 (September 09th 2009)

This morning you will head to the Central Pacific Coast of our country specifically to the area of Jaco Beach. The van will pick you up at 9:00 a.m. and will arrive to Jaco around 1:00 p.m. That will give you enough time to enjoy the beach, the ocean and maybe get some sun to get a sexy tan.

Tonight you will have a Beach Party with a bonfire, dinner, and music!

Day 6 (September 10, 2009)

Jaco Beach was originally a surf town where a lot of locals (costaricans) travel during the weekends. Now is considered one of the main cities in the area with lots of hotels, restaurants, clubs and outdoor activities to choose from. Today all the participants can choose either to take a surfing lessons or walk at the Manuel Antonio National Park.

Manuel Antonio is one of the most visited National Parks in the country. Its located on a white sanded beach and is very easy to spot animals like monkeys, iguanas and sloths. The hike last about 2 hours but the participants can lay on the beach for a couple of hours afterwards.

The surfing lessons are right in front of the hotel, after 2 hours of intensive one on one surfing lessons, you can surf more or just relax at the pool of the resort.

Tonight we have an special night event for you to get the flavor and good vibes from Jaco.

Day 7 (September 11, 2009)

Morning at Jaco and then, after lunch, depart to San José.

This is your last night in Costa Rica, so the better way to say good bye to this peaceful and friendly little country and all the new friends you have made, is doing a party with live music.

We have a reserved area just for the group to enjoy dinner, music and a open bar!

You should arrange the shuttle service of the Hotel to take you to the Juan Santamaria airport. Here you can check in your luggage, buy your departure tax (\$26 p/p) and if you still have a few hours left you can buy liquor and perfumes at the duty free shop located inside the airport.
